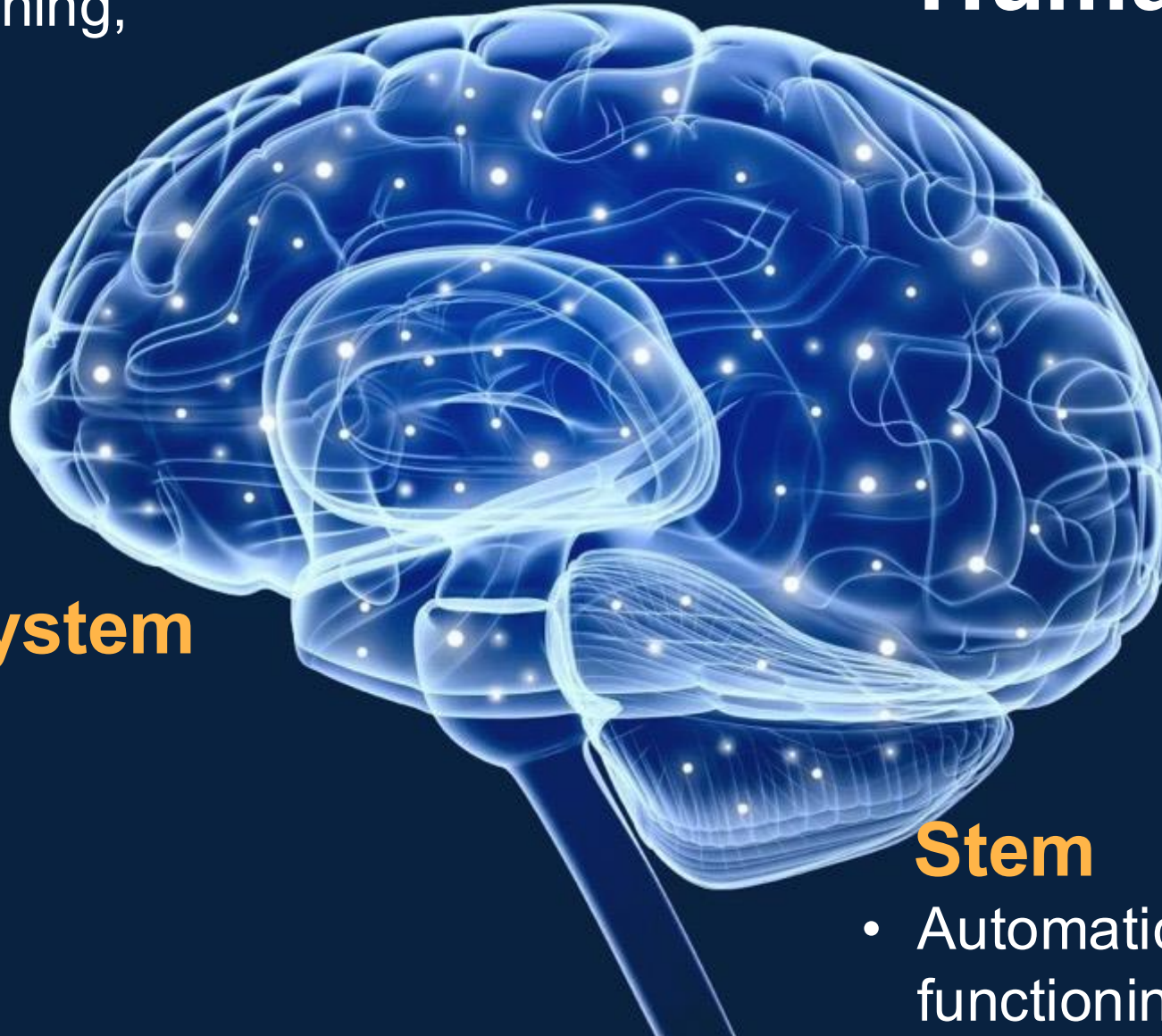

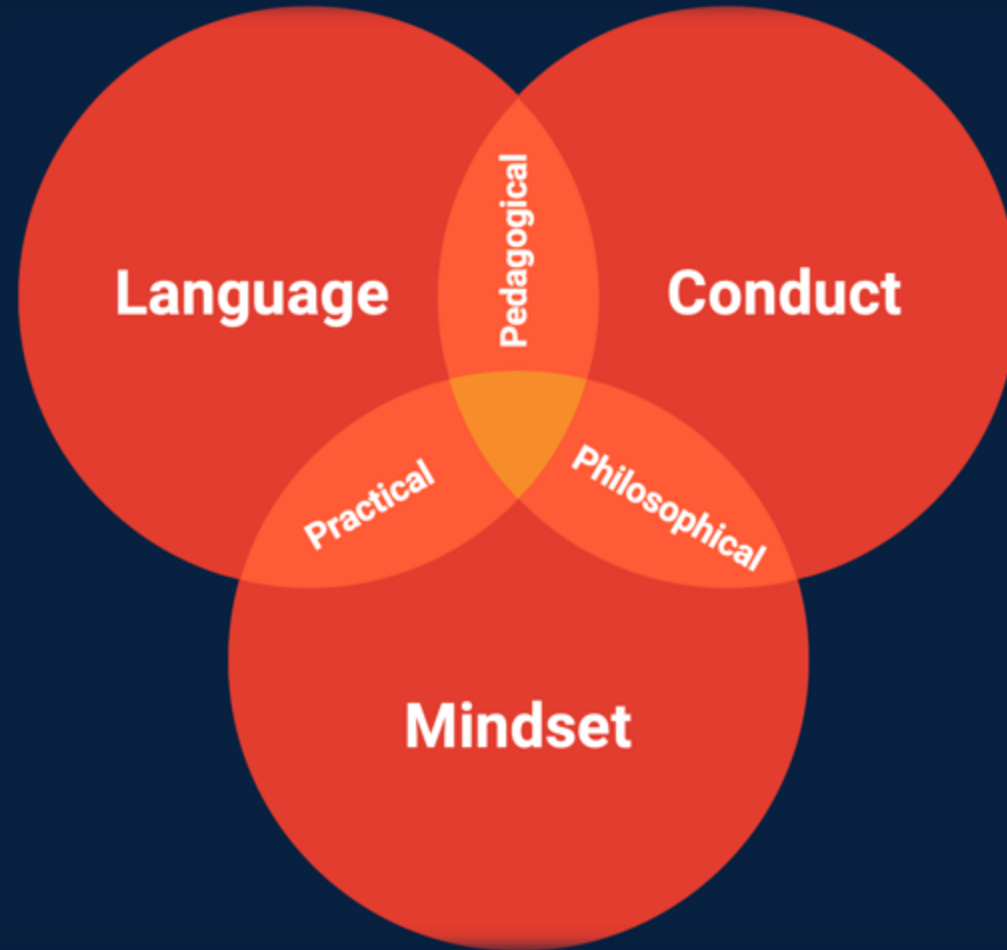
What is Restorative Practice?

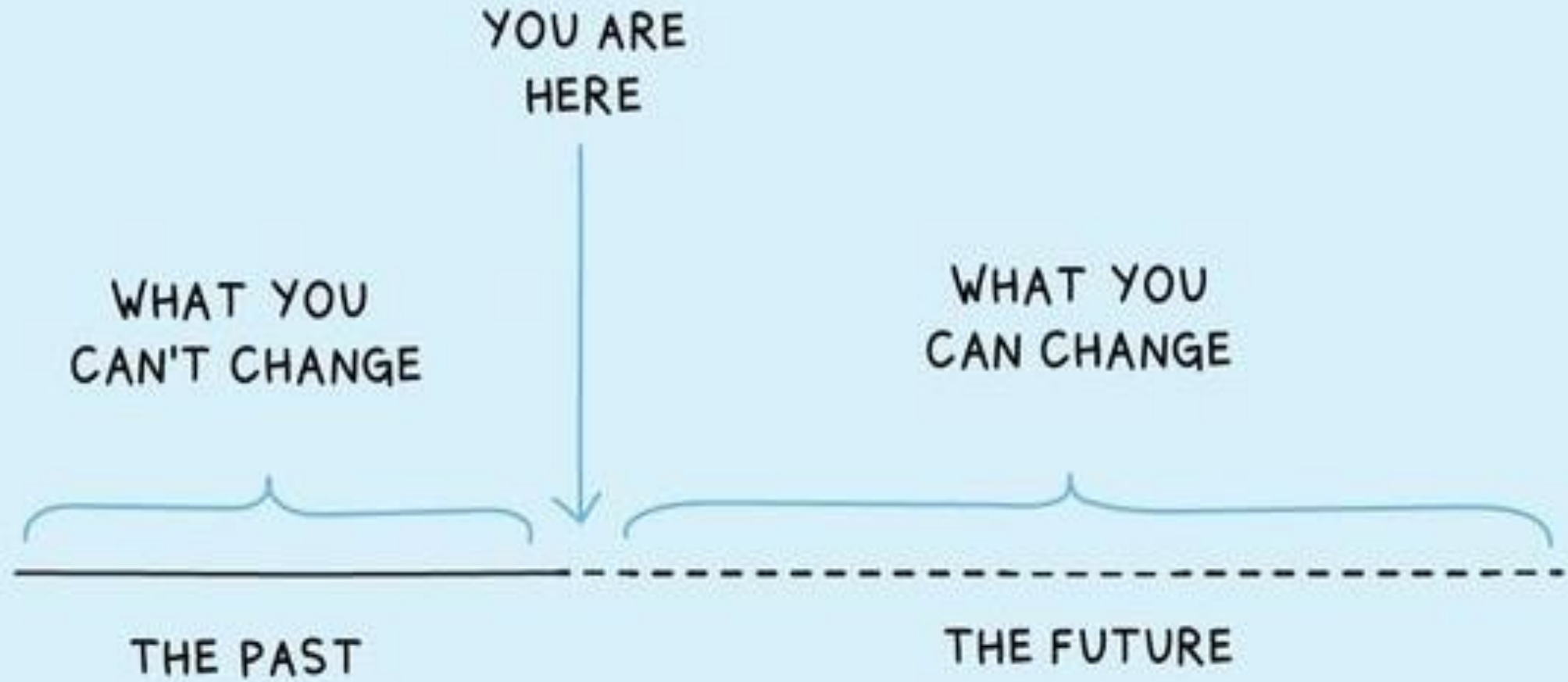

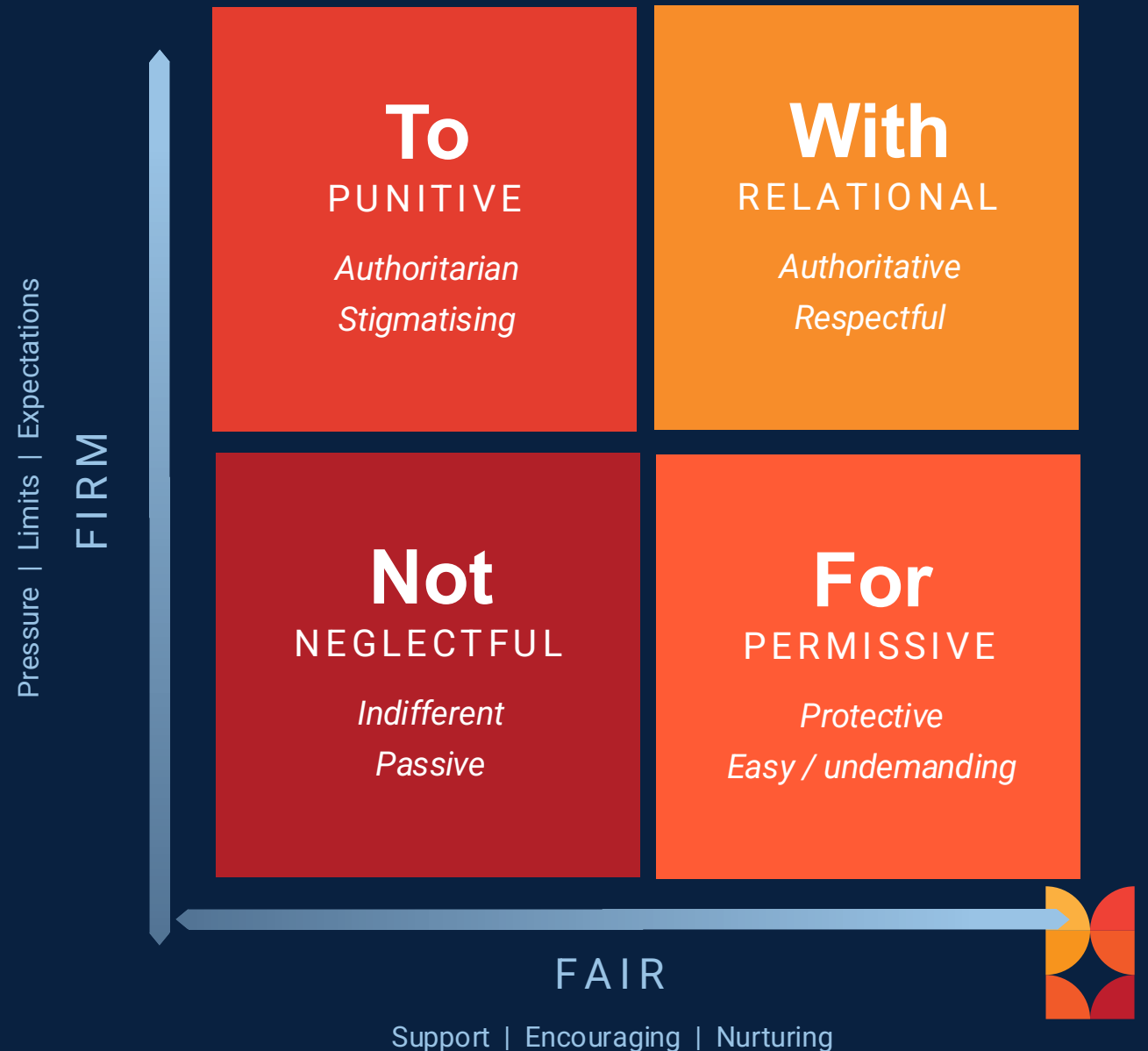
